

The Director's Statement to the Connectional Council The African Methodist Episcopal Zion Church

To the President of the Board of Bishop, Bishop W. Darin Moore, Bishop George E. Battle Jr., the Senior Bishop, Bishop Seth O. Lartey, the host Bishop, Members of the Board of Bishops and Members of the Connectional Council: Greetings in the name of the Father of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ! This is my report as Executive Director of the Department of Church Growth and Development which houses both Evangelism and Home Mission, with highlights, evangelistic endeavors and financial reviews.

THE DEPARTMENT OF CHURCH GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT - The Church Growth and Development department has maintained its obligations in aiding Ministers, Churches and responded to all emergency requests from mission conferences in Episcopal Districts. The administrative Board of Church Growth and Development has held regular conference calls receiving updates from the subcommittees of the following areas: Church Revitalization, Connectional Prayer Ministry, Discipleship Ministry, Evangelism, Audit Committee, Home Mission Budget Committee and Church Planting.

The Department of Church Growth Director was instructed to discontinue assistance for two church plants started by Rev. Charles Thurman Jr. and Rev. Derrick Lamar Smith. The Department of Church Growth and Development have participated in several calls to prayer led by our Prayer Coordinator, Rev. Dr. Eric Leake. The prayer ministry provides ongoing prayer support for the general meeting of the denomination. An overview of the day to day operations of Home Mission, the receipts and disbursements are included in this report.

Decision Day – The 2017 Theme is “Spiritual Directions for a New Generation.” The selected Scripture lessons are 2 Timothy 3:1-13; 4:1-5. Our purpose as New Testament born again believers is to do the work of an evangelist, faithfully sharing the word of Faith that brings salvation to all who believe in their hearts and confess with their mouth the Lord Jesus Christ. Decision Day is rooted and grounded in the quest to see our members, children, youth and adults move beyond religion and ritual to authentic relationships with God through Jesus Christ. While still targeting our youth and children, the Decision Day Observance must broaden its scope to reach people of all ages who needing to make a life-changing decision for Christ. The Decision Day Packets were sent out to the pastors during the month of September. So far 63 churches responded to the Department request, returning the forms and sending gifts in the amount of \$3,100.00.

2018 Spiritual Emphasis Week – Spiritual Emphasis Week offers an opportunity for each local church to begin the year on a high spiritual note. The entire denomination was encouraged to participate as the presiding elder districts gather Sunday through Friday for prayer, praise, and proclamation of the word. This annual event was culminated with the clergy and laity of the Presiding Elder District coming together for a special service. The suggested theme for Spiritual Emphasis Week 2018 was “Spiritual Directions for a New Generation.” The selected Scripture lessons are 2 Timothy 3:1-13; 4:1-5. I was privilege to share Spiritual Emphasis week at the New Home AME Zion Church, Rock Hill, South Carolina for the Rock Hill District Evangelism Committee and Presiding Elder Sharon Browning.

Ecumenical Highlights

The Director represented The African Methodist Episcopal Zion Church during the planning meeting and participating in the 2018 Bold Like Jesus Conference. This year's conference was held February 1-3, 2018, at the St. John Evangelical Lutheran Church, Salisbury, North Carolina. Special thanks to Bishop Kenneth Monroe for allowing Rev. E. Kenneth Wells to represent the Eastern North Carolina Episcopal District, Rev. Dr. Dwayne Walker and the Little Rock AME Zion Church and Bishop George E. Battle Jr. who participated in the event.

The Director participated in the Black Methodist General Officers Meeting held at The Mill House, Charleston, South Carolina, September 15, 16, 2017. During the meeting, Rev. Dr. George Mc Kain was elected President and Dr. David Aiken elected as Chaplain. The AME Zion General Officers are scheduled to host the next meeting at the AME Zion Headquarters, Charlotte, NC.

The Director participated in the October 2017 Evangelism Connections Bi-Annual Meeting hosted by the Reformed Church of America meeting in Phoenix, Arizona and the 2018 meeting hosted by the Presbyterian Church of Canada. Our spring gathering was hosted by The Rev. Dr. Ross Lockhart from the PCC on the beautiful campus of the University of British Columbia. This network of Evangelism and Discipleship Directors are committed to developing new approaches to evangelism in the 21st Century. The group release an interactive study entitled, "Reimagining Evangelism" which includes a downloadable study guide, you tube video clips and leader's guide published by the Discipleship Ministry of the United Methodist Church.

The Bureau of Evangelism Website - The Bureau of Evangelism maintains a site which offers many valuable tools for our constituents around the country and across the world. The feedback received has been overwhelmingly positive. Thanks to Rev. William Dudley, Episcopal Director of the Washington-Oregon Conference, who worked tirelessly, using his skill, generosity and faithfulness in maintaining and updating the site.

Rev. William Dudley passed away this year, I was privileged to serve as eulogist for his service in Seattle, Washington. Special thanks to Bishop Staccato Powell, the presiding elder and the host pastor for the assistance with travel and accommodations. We also maintain three webpages on Facebook posting daily inspirational reflections.

Connectional Networking for Evangelism Opportunities

The Christian Education Department partnered with the Department of Church Growth and Development to provide evangelistic training during their Winter Meeting. The Director taught (2) workshops and provided altar support for the CED winter meeting in Atlanta, Georgia. During the C.E.D. Winter meeting 93 persons responded to the Altar Ministry: 31 received salvation, 24 received assurance of salvation, 2 accepted their call to the ministry and others received special prayer. Each person received counseling, brochures and follow-up letters. Their pastors also received letters informing of what took place during the meeting.

The Director has been invited to present (3) evangelistic presentations during the 24th Quadrennial Convention on Christian Education, here in Birmingham, Alabama. The Connectional Lay Council has provided an opportunity for the director to present workshop during their October 2018 Evangelism Conference. These partnerships have allowed me to raise awareness of evangelism across the AME Zion Connectional.

The World Methodist Evangelism Division of the World Methodist Church

invited several AME Zion, evangelistic-minded pastors and their spouses to participate in their extensive evangelistic training during their 2018 Order of the Flame Conference. Thanks to the Board of Bishops who sent leaders from across the denomination to experience this enriching Wesleyan/Methodist training opportunity. The World Methodist Director of Evangelism, Rev. Dr. Kimberly Wiseman selected Bishop Darryl B. Starnes and the director to lead the Communion services and Rev. Kelcy Steele as a featured preacher. The conference was held March 12-16, 2018 at Saint Simon Island, GA at the Epworth by the Sea.

Theme: The Freedom Church: Reviewing Our Practices

The Book of Discipline of our Church directs that every Sunday Church School shall emphasize "Decision Day" annually in the month of October. It further directs that each Sunday Church School should undertake an evangelistic quota for active membership. In the recent past, the Decision Day Observance has also been an opportunity for the local churches to share financial gifts in support of the Department of Church Growth and Development: *Evangelism & Home Mission*. While financial gifts are welcomed during this observance, the Department of Church Growth and Development is placing its greatest emphasis upon decisions for Christ and faithfulness in ministry.

This year our theme as the Freedom Church is **Reviewing Our Practices**. Our purpose as born again believers is to do the work of an evangelist, faithfully sharing the word of Faith that brings salvation to all who believe in their hearts and confess with their mouth the Lord Jesus Christ. Our definition of evangelism: "Evangelism is the proclamation of the good news of Jesus Christ by words, deeds and signs empowered by the Holy Spirit for the purpose of making disciples for Christ."

Evangelism is not something we do to people; it is what do with the Gospel of Jesus Christ! Doing the work of an evangelist includes warning believers about the challenges they will face in perilous times due to an increase in moral decay, godless formalism, religious persecution, and religious imposters.

More than that, doing the work of an evangelist includes clearly teaching believers the word of God as a firm foundation for building lasting faith and living productive lives. (2 Tim. 3:14, 15) We should be our children's first Christian Educators, teaching them God's word. (2 Tim. 1:5) We should bring them to the church, where they can attend all facets of its teaching ministry. Then we should model life-long study of God's word, helping others discover the benefits of God's word that makes us wise unto salvation. (2 Tim. 3:14, 15)

God gave His only begotten Son, Jesus the Christ to redeem his people and establish His Church at the price of His Son's blood. For more than 2000 years, He has guarded and protected the Church from corruption, heresy and persecution. Then God gave His Holy Spirit to direct and empower His church. God's agenda has not changed. The Freedom Church must review our practices, examine our conduct and demonstrate our faith as Christian disciples. Then review our practices as we fulfill our purpose to making Christian disciples and helping Christian disciples become Christian disciple makers.

This year, God is calling His Church back to the basics: being a disciple of Christ and helping others to do the same. Decision Day 2018 is rooted and grounded in the quest to see all our members, children, youth and adults move beyond religion and ritual to authentic relationships with God through Jesus Christ. While still targeting our youth and children, the Decision Day Observance must broaden its scope in order to reach people of all ages who are in need of making a life-changing decision for Christ.
